Supv. Triolo informed the board the agreement between the town and Teamsters, Local 338, highway workers contract will expire on Dec. 31, 2010. Contract negotiations are pending. There will be an approximate 10% increase in the cost of health insurance.

The Comprehensive Plan was further discussed. The committee is working on the Vision Statement.

Doug Murphy questioned the ownership of the culvert by the Eagle's Nest on Delaware Co. Hwy. 18. According to Delaware Co. Public Works Commissioner Wayne Reynolds the culvert is located in the Village of Stamford. Supv. Triolo will contact Mr. Reynolds and discuss.
